**Vaughan:** I have really dark hair, like my mother, so when it's wet or has product in it, it has that greasy look. With the highlights, it helps break it up, gives it layers, so it doesn't look like "helmet head."  
**Digest:** Have you gotten fan comments about going back to dark hair?  
**Vaughan:** They like it better the natural color. If there comes another time where I can go shorter, I can put a little blonde in to give it dimension. I'd totally do it.  
**Digest:** What's been the most drastic thing you've been asked to do with your hair?  
**Vaughan:** From my modeling days — I sat four hours in a chair for a magazine shoot. My hair was

**Vaughan:** I really want to shave my head.  
**Digest:** Which celeb's hair do you most covet?  
**Vaughan:** Brad Pitt has great hair; he can do anything and pull it off. Johnny Depp — oh, my God — the guy can grow his hair down to his ass and it's still cool.

**Digest:** Have you ever been given an edict about your hair?  
**Vaughan:** Actually, Aaron Spelling gave me an edict. I was on *MALIBU SHORES*. My hair had to stay long for nine months. I hated it.  
**Digest:** Is your hairstyle more a reflection of you or Lucky?  
**Vaughan:** Probably more of me. I'm the third Lucky and our hairstyles are completely different. I can grow my hair really long and pull it off, but I find that it ages me. I like the shortness now; it makes it easy to maintain. It's always cool.

**Digest:** Do you spend a lot of time on your hair?  
**Vaughan:** Definitely not. When I come to work, I do play with my hair — because I don't have the accessibility to everything there is in the makeup room at home.

**Anderson** (laughs): I'd trim his hair every day if he did that! □



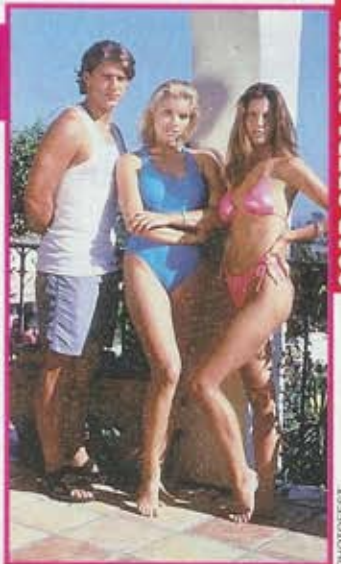
